BOARD ACTION ITEM B-1: Amend Treasurers' Contract

5. Benefits: Vacation

B: The Treasurer shall receive **twenty-five (25)** work days of vacation annually, exclusive of legal holidays. Vacation should be credited at the beginning of each contact year. In the event the Treasurer voluntarily leaves the School District in any contract year, the **twenty-five (25)** days shall be computed on an accrual basis in determining the appropriate number of paid vacation days allowable for that year.

The Treasurer may elect at the end of the fiscal year to be paid, at her per diem rate, for up to 5 days of accrued vacation not used. Such payment, if elected, will be deemed additional salary and result in a reduction of days from the balance of the Treasurer's accumulated vacation total equal to the days paid. Such payment, if elected, will be made within 30 days.
