*Ohio Revised Code (ORC) requires K-6 students to receive 910 hours of instruction and 7-12 students receive 1001 hours. Per ORC, districts count the equivalent number of instructional hours for two days of parent-teacher conferences and two days of teacher professional meetings. The district will use up to three blizzard bag days and/or add school days at the end of the year in the event additional student instructional time is needed to meet State minimum standards.

Dear T-M Families:

Beginning next year, all school buildings will be fully operational again. In order to focus on students' academic and developmental needs at each level, the district will be structured into the following grade bands:

Early Learning Center: Preschool – Grade 1

Madison Park: Grades 2 – 3

Westbrooke Village: Grades 4 – 5

Middle School: Grades 6 – 8

High School: Grades 9 – 12

School calendars have always been based on a minimum number of days. Ohio legislators have voted on new rules regarding when students attend school. Starting next year, all school calendars are to be based on hours. The following is the minimum number of instructional hours for students:

Preschool: 455 hours annually; K-6: 910 hours annually; 7-12: 1001 hours annually

The revised calendar has students starting school almost a week earlier in August and ending the Friday before Memorial Day. This structure allows for additional learning time prior to State assessments in the Spring. K-1 students will have an increase of 90 instructional hours a year; those in grades 2-5 are scheduled for 80 instructional hours above State minimum standards; and grades 6-12 will see an increase of 79 instructional hours annually.

The calendar is open to public review and feedback for 30 days. There will be face-to-face meetings scheduled in each school building to explain the benefits of the new calendar and provide citizens an opportunity to ask questions. Building principals will notify families of the meeting date and time for their respective schools.

To be in compliance with law, the Trotwood-Madison Board of Education will take action on the revised calendar at its May 15, 2014 meeting.
