# Progress Book

## MONITORING YOUR CHILD'S CLASS WORK

For families who have children in our schools, remember that you can monitor your child's progress through the electronic gradebook, Progress Book. If you have more than one child in Trotwood-Madison City Schools, you can group them together under one login, so you see all your children listed under your name. Here's how to do that.

1. Go to our homepage, [www.trotwood.k12.oh.us](http://www.trotwood.k12.oh.us), and click on the Progress Book link on the left side. Then click on one of the red Progress Book buttons.
2. Scroll down to find the Trotwood-Madison City Schools logo and click on it. Then go to the upper right corner to login. If you don't know your login, it will be coming home in a letter at the beginning of the school year or you can call your child's school. If you had a login from last year, you can use that one; it will still be valid.
3. Once you are logged in, click on the "My Account" tab at the top right. Click on "Link My Accounts" and follow the prompts. You will need the login name and password for each student you want to link. When you have linked all your students, then click on the "Student" tab, and your students will be listed on the left side at the top.

Progress Book is a great way for parents to keep an eye on their child's progress. So when your student comes home and says they have no homework and everything is fine in class, you can log in, check their progress in a specific class and see if everything is indeed fine.

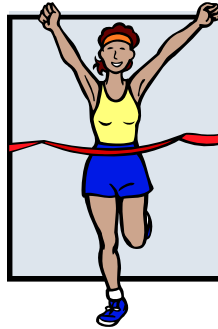
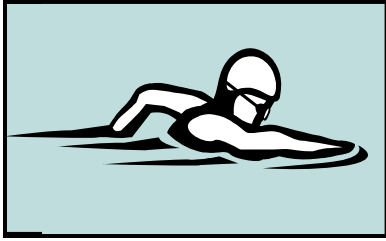
