Positive Behavior Interventions and Support

- A school-wide system aimed at teaching and supporting positive behavior.
- Preventative in nature.
- Provides support for students and staff to encourage positive behaviors.
- Addresses classroom management and disciplinary issues (e.g., attendance, tardies, and antisocial behavior)
- Maximizes academic engagement and achievement for ALL students.
- Uses data to make decisions.

Fabulous Fridays

Students will receive a pass on Thursdays if they have met the criteria to participate. The pass will have the weekly theme, which may include: out of uniform, silly socks, crazy hat, pick a snack, etc.

Criteria:

- Students must END on 'Activating Super Powers' or higher, 5 days (Friday-Thursday).
- Students must have PERFECT ATTENDANCE (No tardies or absences).
- Homework and classwork must be completed.

Quarterly Reward

Criteria:
