Dear Parents/Guardians,

If you would like for your child to attend Trotwood-Madison City Schools as an Open Enrolled student for the 2023-2024 school year, you must complete an Open Enrollment application, AND provide all of the required documents. You must submit:

- 1. Parent Agreement for Open Enrollment
- 2. Copy of current state identification of parent/legal guardian
- 3. Birth certificates (copies or hospital birth records are accepted)
- 4. Proof of residency (see back of this letter for acceptable proof of residency)
- 5. Court filed stamped documents (custody, divorce decrees, foster-placed, etc.)
- 6. Copy of current & updated immunization records
- 7. Attendance records (most recent school year)
- 8. Discipline records (most recent school year)
- 9. Copy of report card (grades K-8)
- 10. Copy of transcript (grades 9-11 only)
- 11. IEP and ETR (if applicable)
- 12. 504 Plan (if applicable)

Application and all documents must be submitted at the same time. They can be submitted at enrollment@trotwood.k12.oh.us or in the Open Enrollment Drop Box at the Trotwood-Madison City Schools Board of Education Office (3594 N. Snyder Road, Trotwood, Ohio 45426) between 8:00-4:00pm daily. Applications with missing items will not be accepted or processed.

Notification of acceptance or denial will be made by the appropriate building principal, and families will be notified on or before June 15, 2023.

Failure to submit your application & all required documents on or before May 26th may cause your child to lose the opportunity to attend Trotwood-Madison City Schools, as enrollment is **not** guaranteed or promised.

Acceptable Proof of Residency

Per Ohio Revised Code, these are the documents that are acceptable to verify residence of students.

- Home purchase agreement
- Deed
- Mortgage
- Current real estate property tax bill
- Valid lease agreement
- Current homeowner's/renter's insurance declaration page
- Utility bill or receipt of utility installation (AES, Vectren, Water) no more than 30 days old
- Paycheck or paystub with parent's name and primary residence listed (check must be issued within 90 days of enrollment)
- Most current bank statement that includes parent's primary residence
- USPS return receipt from certified letter sent to parents by district of residence
- Written confirmation from the Department of Job and Family Services of current address of the parent(s)
- Written confirmation from a local law enforcement agency of the current address of the parent(s)
- Notarized affirmation from the parent(s) or student(s) if over 18-years of age of current residence address

Trotwood-Madison City Schools PARENT ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF INTER-DISTRICT OPEN ENROLLMENT POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

Enrollment is effective for the 2023-2024 school year only

The undersigned parent/guardian of	understands and acknowledges
the following policies and procedures a	applicable to inter-district open enrollment in Trotwood-Madison School
District:	

- Our child's application may be rejected for the following reasons: (1) if maximum number of enrollments in the classroom or program for which we are applying exceeds capacity limits set by Trotwood-Madison School district; (2) if our child is receiving services under Chapter 3323 of the Revised Code and the services described in our child's IEP are not available in the district's schools; or (3) if our child has been suspended or expelled for ten consecutive days or more in the semester for which admission is sought or in the preceding semester.
- If approved for enrollment, all rules, regulations, and policies of the Trotwood-Madison School District shall apply to open enrollment students to the same extent as they apply to native students. Admitted students are expected to adhere to district attendance and discipline policies. Violations may result in disciplinary action. Our child will be required to abide by the rules and regulations set forth in the Trotwood-Madison Student Code of Conduct.
- If applying for Kindergarten, our child must meet the age requirement set forth by the Trotwood-Madison School District. This means that our child will be 5 years old on or before September 30.
- If our child should require special education services, he/she may be assigned or transferred to another school in the Trotwood-Madison School District which provides such services, if the school he/she is attending cannot provide the same.
- We are responsible for providing the transportation for our child to and from the Trotwood-Madison School District.
- Ohio High Schools Athletic Association eligibility guidelines will be in effect for a student in grades 7-12. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian/student to request an athletic release from the Board of Education from the resident district. Any enrolled adjacent-district may lose their eligibility to participate in tournament or sporting contests for a period of time if or when they return to the home district. Students and parents are urged to become aware of and consider these athletic guidelines before submitting the application for open enrollment.
- Once notified, Parents/Guardians must indicate their acceptance of the Open Enrollment. As a
 condition of the Open Enrollment we must agree to have all personally identifiable data on file in the
 child's current/previous school district forwarded to Trotwood-Madison Schools. Failure to provide such
 permission will result in this offer being withdrawn, thus allowing other students to be considered for an
 available opening.
- The enrollment is only for the <u>2023-2024 school year</u>, and we must make the application again next vear.
